

Section 350 - Issuance of Citations

350.01 Except as otherwise provided by Statute, only a peace officer and part time peace officer may ask a person receiving a citation to give written promise to appear in Court or take the person into custody as permitted by Minnesota Statute 629.34 (1986).

350.02 The City Manager and His or her designee may issue citations in lieu of arrest or continued detention for violations of the Hopkins City Code.(Amended Ord. 2004-917)

350.03 Preservation of Statutory and Common Law Rights. The provisions of this ordinance will not limit or impair the statutory or common law right of the employees holding the positions enumerated in 350.02 to make citizen arrests or issue citations for violations of state laws and municipal ordinances.

350.04 Savings Clause. If any provision of this ordinance should be adjudged void or of no effect for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not effect the validity of any of the other portions of the ordinance.
