Conditions for use of the fire pit

- The applicant must ensure that a responsible adult, knowledgeable in the use of the extinguishing equipment, is present at the fire pit at all times.
- A means shall be provided to extinguish the fire. This can include buckets, shovels, or a minimum 4-A rated fire extinguisher.
- Fires shall be extinguished before leaving the area.
- Fires shall be extinguished if deemed unsafe or a nuisance by the Hopkins Police Department, Fire Department or Public Works Department.
- All firewood must be brought into the park. Firewood must be clean, dry, unpainted, untreated wood.
- All unused wood must be removed from the park.
- No accelerants shall be used to start or maintain fires.
- Fire/flames must not exceed 3 feet in height.
- Fire must be contained to within the fire pit.

The applicant hereby agrees to comply with the above conditions. Further, the applicant agrees that this fire will not be left unattended at any time, and will be supervised by applicant or applicant's designated representative until the fire is completely extinguished. At any time during the use of the fire pit the City deems there to be an unsafe condition or if a fire-related nuisance complaint has been received, the fire will be extinguished immediately.
