- ▶ **Transparent**: Through openness we will build trust and mutual understanding.









Calls for Service

- ▶ We have to respond to calls to resolve the situation, regardless of difficulty, who is involved, or danger
 - ▶ Police are called when the situation can no longer be controlled by the caller
 - ▶ There is no one else
- ▶ Problem solving / Judgement / Experience
 - ▶ Verbal de-escalation
 - ▶ Use of force
 - ▶ Arrest
 - ▶ Other services
 - ▶ All while considering:
 - ▶ Policy, State Statute, Case law, POST board rules, public perception, etc.

- ▶ Probation – 1 year




Training

- ▶ Regional response




Patrol Duties

Investigations

- ▶ Three detectives in general investigations
 - ▶ One drug task force position
- ▶ Crime Analyst
- ▶ Investigations:
 - ▶ Prepare cases for attorneys
 - ▶ Work closely with city and county prosecutors
 - ▶ Handle cases that need further follow up
 - ▶ Serious assaults, robberies, complex thefts, etc.
 - ▶ Execute search warrants, locate and arrest suspects
 - ▶ Work with child protection and adult protection
 - ▶ Saturation Details
